



Dear Student,

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, St. John's University is able to offer financial assistance grants through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF III) to students to help them pay for certain education-related expenses such as tuition, books, food, housing, health care (including mental health), and/or child care.

We are writing to you because our records indicate that you have been identified as eligible for a 2021-2022 Federal Pell Grant, and as such the University has deemed you to be automatically eligible to receive a one-time financial assistance grant. To facilitate the disbursement of your financial assistance grant, follow the steps below:

- Go to signon.stjohns.edu and log into your personal **UIS** account.
- Select the Personal Information Tab on UIS, and then select **Answer a Survey**.
- Under Current Surveys, select **ARP/HEERF III Federal Funds Form**.
- **Please complete the ARP/HEERF III Federal Funds Form by Friday, August 20, 2021.**
