

## Dear Student,

St. John's University is pleased to share that we are in receipt of your CRRSAA/HEERF II Federal Funds Form and **you have been awarded \$1,150.** 

On your form, you requested that any grant received be applied to your balance. A review of your account was performed and, as requested, funds were applied to any qualified balance. Please review your personal UIS account, as your account will reflect the payment.

In the event that there was no qualified balance, or if the grant amount exceeded the qualified balance, a direct payment has been issued. Federal guidelines did not permit the University to post grants as a credit against future term charges.

The University has strived to assist as many students as possible with the CRRSAA/HEERF II funding. The funds awarded may be used towards any component of your Cost of Education, such as tuition, books, food, housing, health care (including mental health) or child care.

This emergency financial assistance is intended to provide direct one-time grant assistance. This emergency funding is considered a form of federal emergency relief and as such is not considered to be part of your Financial Aid Package and is excluded from your taxable income under Section 139 of the Internal Revenue Code.

A direct payment, if required, will be distributed as follows: students signed up for Direct Deposit will have funds deposited to their account within 3 business days, students not signed up for Direct Deposit will be issued a paper check which will be mailed to the address on file with the University.
