Dear Student,

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, St. John's University is able to offer financial assistance grants through the Federal Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF II) to a limited number of students to help them pay for certain education-related expenses such as tuition, books, food, housing, health care (including mental health), and/or child care.

We are writing to you because our records indicate that you completed the 2020-21 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), and that you may be eligible to receive a one-time financial assistance grant. To apply for the financial assistance grant, follow the steps below.

- Go to signon.stjohns.edu and log into your personal **UIS** account.
- Select the Personal Information Tab on UIS, select **Answer a Survey**.
- **Under Current Surveys, select CRRSAA/HEERF II Federal Fund Application and complete by April 6th.**

Applicants will be notified of their eligibility to receive a financial assistance grant as soon as possible. Grant amounts depend on eligibility and the number of applications received. If you have not already signed up for [Direct Deposit](#), we strongly encourage you to do so.
