

## Fast Facts Fall 2007

- Total enrollment **20,086**
    - 14,798 Undergraduate Students
    - 5,288 Graduate Students - largest number since 1980
  - **3,162** New Freshmen
  - Students come from **45** States, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, US Virgin Islands and **122** countries
  - **1,055** Non-resident (International) Students, the largest number ever enrolled, come from **108** countries

- **58%** Female
  - **49%** Roman Catholic
  - **38%** are Black, Hispanic, Asian/Pacific Islander or Native American
  - Approximately **3,000** students live in residence facilities on and around the Queens, Staten Island and Manhattan campuses
  - **3,973** degrees conferred during the 2006-2007 academic year
  - UG tuition — **\$26,200** (varies by program and class year)
  - **95%** of undergraduates receive financial aid
  - **\$337.6** million distributed in Financial Aid
  - **Over 3,200** employees
