2) DIRECTIONS TO THE HOTEL FROM AREA AIRPORTS

I. JFK

- Take the Van Wyck Expressway to Grand Central Parkway West. Stay on the right and exit onto the Long Island Expressway. Continue onto Midtown Tunnel. Pay toll. Follow signs for Downtown to FDR Drive South. Take FDR Drive to the end. Follow signs to West St. (North). Hotel is on West St. between Carlisle & Albany Sts.
- Hotel direction is 20 miles South West.
- Estimated taxi fare from the airport is \$45.00 (one way).

II. LGA

- Follow signs to New Jersey Turnpike North. Follow to exit 14C (Holland Tunnel). Exit the tunnel and make first right hand turn onto Laight St. Go 3 blocks and make a left onto West St. Stay in the far right lanes and follow to the end. Make a left onto Battery Place, then another left to return to West St. (You'll now be on the north bound lanes). Follow to the hotel at 85 West St. between Carlisle and Albany Sts.
- Hotel direction is 15 Miles South West.
- Estimated taxi fare from the airport is \$45:00 (one way). There is also a bus service for about \$12:00 (one way).

III. NEWARK
