BACKGROUND

- Founded by the Vincentian Community in 1870
- Mission: Catholic, Vincentian, and Metropolitan
- Core Values: truth, love, respect, opportunity, excellence, and service

ADMINISTRATION, FACULTY, AND STAFF

- President: Rev. Donald J. Harrington, C.M., - 15th President
- A budget of \$347 million; and a market value of an endowment of \$305 million
- Over 3,100 employees:
 - Faculty: Full-time - 648; Part-time - 865; Full-time Equivalent (FTE): 977
 - Administrators: Full-time - 726; Part-time - 92
 - Staff: Full-time - 591; Part-time - 200

COMPOSITION

- Five campuses – Queens, Staten Island, Oakdale, Manhattan, NY & Rome, Italy
- Six schools and colleges:
 - St. John's College of Liberal Arts and Sciences*
 - The School of Education*
 - The Peter J. Tobin College of Business*
 - College of Pharmacy and Allied Health Professions*
 - College of Professional Studies*
 - School of Law*
- Over one hundred undergraduate and graduate majors
- Approximate acreage: Queens-96.5 acres; Staten Island-16.5 acres; Oakdale-175 acres

STUDENTS

- Fall 2006 Total Enrollment: - 20,069
 - Undergraduate- 14,983; Graduate -5,086;
 - Freshmen -3,266 - *Largest class ever*
- Resident students: Queens -2,604; Staten Island - 241 ; Manhattan - 120
- 46 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, & US Virgin Islands are represented
- 5% Non-Residents(International) students from 105 countries
- 10% Non-Residents and permanent residents from 126 countries
- Average ages: undergraduate - 20; graduate - 29; new freshmen - 18
- 59% female, 41% male
- 50% Roman Catholic
- 39% are Black, Hispanic, Asian/Pacific Islander, or American Indian
- Composite baccalaureate 1st year retention rate 1998-2005: 81%; 2005-2006: 78%
- Composite six-year graduation rate 1998-00: 63%; Class of 2000 - 59%
- 3,954 degrees conferred in the 2005-2006 academic year

ANNUAL EXPENSES (2006-2007)

- Undergraduate Tuition - \$24,400 (varies by program and class year)
Fees: \$570 Room/board: \$11,470 Four-year fixed tuition rate available.
- Graduate Tuition - \$770 per credit (varies by program)

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION (2005-2006)

- 97% of undergraduates received financial aid.
- 40% of freshmen Pell-eligible/Very High Need
- \$315.9 million distributed in financial aid.
- \$126.9 million of university monies distributed to students.
