



## NBA Associate Program and Summer Internship Program

Our Associate Program and Summer Internship Program are designed to enhance business skills and offer students the opportunity to gain exposure to the many facets of our organization. Opportunities are typically available in areas of our business such as:

The **Summer Internship Program** gives matriculating students a chance to build on their work experience and learn about what goes on outside the lines and behind the scenes of a basketball court. This 10-week summer program also gives Interns the opportunity to participate in a series of events and activities that provides exposure to the varied facets of the NBA's business. This past summer, Interns were involved in everything from grassroots activities to television production to community relations.

The **Associate Program** is a 12-month developmental program targeting college graduates. Associates are placed within a specific department at the NBA and are exposed to a range of business activities. Associates are also provided with comprehensive personal development training. Opportunities that the current Associate class is receiving include business writing, communication skills, and even leadership training! These up-close, real-life learning experiences are designed to prepare Associates in becoming key contributors to the NBA organization upon the successful completion of the program.

For either program, applicants are placed within the NBA based on interest, experience, academics, and the NBA's business needs. All positions are located at the NBA League offices in either midtown Manhattan or Secaucus, New Jersey. In addition, students will have access to a wide range of activities and be exposed to all that goes on at the NBA in creating the greatest game in the world...Basketball!

To qualify for the Intern Program, students **must** be enrolled in a college or university at the undergraduate level and be in their sophomore or junior year. Interns must be able to dedicate full time hours, Monday through Friday, for the full 10-week program. To qualify for the Associate Program, students **must** be enrolled in an accredited undergraduate college and anticipating graduation in the Spring. Associates are expected to work full time hours over the course of one calendar year. All students must be in good academic standing and have basic computer skills as well as excellent written and verbal communication skills.
