

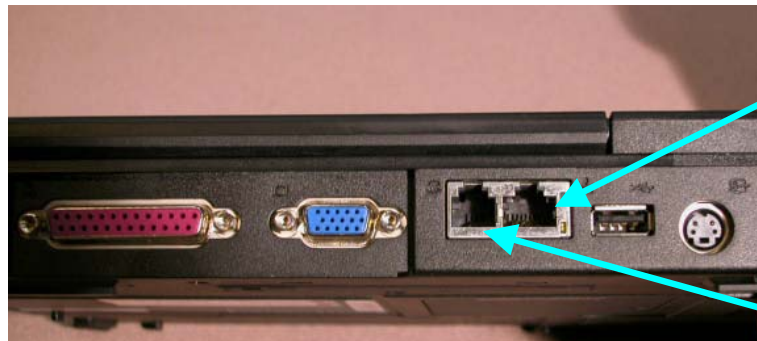
Patch (Ethernet) Instructions

The IBM laptops issued or sold through St. John's University are wireless. Some areas on campus are not wireless. This is why we provided you with a Patch/Ethernet cable. In addition you may use it at home with your DSL/Cable modem. Using this will allow you to access the Internet on campus.

1. The Patch cable or the Ethernet cable looks like an over-sized phone cord (see below)



2. On the back of your laptop there are 2 plugs, one for a phone cord and the other for the Patch/Ethernet cable.

3. Insert one end of the Patch/Ethernet cable into your laptop and the other to the wall Ethernet jack as shown below.
