In addition, you will need at least **15 credits** in:

Mathematics (3 cr.)

Biological science (3 cr.)

Physical science (3 cr.)

Social and behavioral sciences (6 cr.)

Although some of these latter 15 credits may be completed after a student has been admitted in our graduate program. Admission into the program is based on your cumulative index and major index; your undergraduate **GPA minimum must be 3.0**; GRE scores are only required if you are applying for a Graduate Assistantship. You should have completed the pre-requisites before matriculating, although you may apply while you are still enrolled in some of them.
