Physician Assistant students were on hand to help screen blood pressure at the University's annual Wellness Fair on September 17. A record number of participants came to check their blood pressure and ask questions related to healthy living and lifestyles, including the prevention of hypertension and heart disease, weight control, exercise, stress relief, and improved sleep.

Community Service

On September 20, students joined Pamela Gregory-Fernandez, Associate Professor, Industry Professional, in the Alzheimer's Association's Walk to End Alzheimer's at Flushing Meadows Corona Park. This is the association's signature fundraising event and raises more than \$1.4 million annually.

In addition to volunteering during a highly rigorous academic year, students were able to generate a high level of awareness among their peers, family, and friends to raise more than \$1,000.

Students also worked with the St. John's chapter of Women in Science to lead a workshop during a STEM event for middle school children held on a Saturday at St. John's. Finally, PA students attended the first of several blood pressure screenings at a St. John's women's basketball game on December 3. They are looking forward to holding more screenings at games during the men's and women's basketball season.
