STUDENT BODY DIVERSITY (*Full-time Undergraduates*)

 - 44% Male and 56% Female
- Ethnicity of Full-time Undergraduates:
 - 17% Black
 - 17% Asian
 - 10% Hispanic
 - 37% White
 - .4% Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander
 - 6% Non-Resident (International)
 - 5% Two or More Races
 - .5% American Indian
 - 8% Unknown
- 40% of the population were Federal Pell Grant Recipients

RETENTION RATES

- 84% of Fall 2015 Full-time, First-time Baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking freshmen students returned in Fall 2016. 84% of Fall 2015 All full-time, first-time Associate and baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking students returned in Fall 2016.
