

### Instructions

Placement exams are assessments designed to place you in the appropriate course(s).

Do not seek help while completing the exam.

#### **Technical Requirements:**

- **Device:** You must use a desktop or laptop computer to take the exam. **DO NOT** use an iPad, kindle or smart phone.
- **Browser:** The placement exams require the use of *Respondus LockDown Browser*. No other browser will work to take the exam (see instructions on next page).
- **Webcam:** You must have a webcam enabled on your laptop. If you do not have a webcam, please call the University Freshman Center at (718) 990-5858 to arrange an alternative method for the exam to be completed.
- Adobe Flash: You must have Adobe Flash installed to Internet Explorer (for Windows) or Safari (for Mac), even if a different browser is normally used. The first time the Webcam Check is performed on a computer, Adobe Flash Player will require you to select Allow and Remember. To update your Flash, navigate to <a href="https://get.adobe.com/flashplayer/">https://get.adobe.com/flashplayer/</a>.
- Latest version of Java: Enable Java before you start the exam. Navigate to https://java.com/en/download/ to update your Java if necessary.
  - For MAC: Apple supplies their own version of Java. Use the Software Update feature (available on the Apple menu) to check your version of Java.

#### Information to read before taking the exam:

- Sample questions are available on Blackboard.
- Please have scrap paper and a pencil ready before you begin the exam.
- You may not use a calculator for the exam.
- Do not click the refresh button in the browser. You will be locked out of the exam.

# **How to Access the Placement Exams**

### Step 1: Download and Install Respondus LockDown Browser:

#### For computers with Windows:

- Navigate to <a href="http://tinyurl.com/RespondusWindows">http://tinyurl.com/RespondusWindows</a> to download the program.
- During the installation, select "Yes" if prompted to accept programs from Respondus.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the install.
- SAVE the downloaded Respondus Browser to your "DESKTOP."

### For Mac computers:

- Be sure that OSX 10.7 or higher is being used (512K RAM minimum).
- Navigate to <a href="http://tinyurl.com/RespondusMac">http://tinyurl.com/RespondusMac</a> to download the program.
- Follow the download page instructions to obtain the correct installation program.
- Start the LockDown Browser installation program and follow the onscreen instructions to complete the installation.
- SAVE the downloaded Respondus Browser to "Doc."

# Troubleshooting for the installation of Respondus LockDown Browser:

# Step 2: Access the exam(s) after installing Respondus LockDown Browser

- Close all programs, unless one is used to connect you to the Internet.
- Locate the "LockDown Browser" shortcut on the desktop and double-click it. (For Mac users, launch "LockDown Browser" from the "Dock" or "Applications" folder.)
- If other programs are open and running on your computer, a pop-up box will prompt you to close them. Select "YES" on the pop-up box.
- In your Respondus LockDown Browser, type in your user name: firstname.lastname18. For example: If your name is John Smith, you would enter john.smith18
  - o Be sure to put a period ( . ) between your first and last names.
- Type in your six-digit password: MMDDYY (your date of birth) For example, if your birthday is September 1, 1997, you would enter 090197. Your password is the same password that is used in UIS. If you have changed your UIS password please use your updated password to log on to blackboard.
- Click "Login" to enter Blackboard.
- Click on the appropriate exam.
- Please read the instructions carefully and click on the name of the exam.
- Click the red "Begin" box on the right to start the exam and begin the one hour timer.
- When you finish each exam click "Save all answers", then "Save and submit." If you exit the exam before the "Save and Submit" button is clicked you will not be able to return to the exam.
- Click "OK" to review your score.
