



Transfer Merit Scholarships*

All transfer students to St. John's are considered for transfer scholarships, which may qualify them for up to \$17,000 annually. Phi Theta Kappa members are also eligible for an additional annual scholarship of up to \$2,000.

**Transfer scholarships may be renewed for up to three years if the student maintains minimum grade point average requirements while continuously enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student at St. John's University.*
