You can prepare for exciting opportunities in the media through the Television and Film Studies Program at St. John's University. Through its College of Professional Studies, St. John's offers a two-year, 61-credit track leading to the Associate of Science degree and a four-year, 126-credit program leading to the Bachelor of Science degree.

Both programs offer students considerable flexibility and thorough preparation for a career in the television, film, advertising, journalism, media graphics, public relations, publishing, and video production industries.

To instill a broad understanding of media, the curriculum provides a professional dimension in the educational, managerial, and creative phases of television, film, advertising, public relations, and journalism. Students take courses in production, media writing, industry organization and procedures, media history, and aesthetics. They also receive a solid foundation in liberal arts, business administration, and marketing.

Students can take courses in the day or evening on both the Queens and Staten Island campuses.
