Criminal justice refers to the study of agencies of social control that respond to all aspects of criminal and civil procedures. These agencies include police departments, courts, and correctional facilities.

THE PROGRAM

The undergraduate program in Criminal Justice at St. John's University gives students a comprehensive understanding of our multifaceted criminal justice system. Along with specific courses in criminal justice theory and application, the curriculum includes a solid, interdisciplinary liberal arts foundation. This foundation gives students the broad knowledge and skills to become intelligent, ethical, humane decision makers and leads them into future occupations in both the public and private sectors in areas such as law and government.

An innovative specialization in forensic psychology is a special feature of the program.

SPECIALIZED COURSES
