Childhood Education Master of Science Programs (1–6)

Childhood Education 1–6 (M.S.Ed.)

• Continuing Education Program (33 credits)

This program is intended for students who wish to pursue a master's degree in the same academic area as their initial certification.

• Field Change (33 credits)

This program is designed for students who have received or have qualified for an initial certification other than childhood education.

• Career Change (42 credits for the master's degree, plus deficiencies, if required for New York State certification)

This program is designed for students whose academic background is outside the field of education.

Benefits of Program

The Department of Curriculum and Instruction provides three programs of study related to childhood education that encompass a range of teaching and learning experiences through relevant pedagogical methods and a broad knowledge of strategies. Each of the programs leads to a Master of Science in Education degree.

According to the New York City Department of Education (NYC DOE), "St. John's graduates were rated highest in retention, the percentage of teachers still employed in the NYC DOE three years after hire; were second-best in tenure approval; had the lowest receiving 'unsatisfactory' ratings their first year; and 91 percent of its teacher graduates were rated 'highly effective' or 'effective' as reflected in student growth scores on fourth- through eighth-grade math and English tests."

In 2017, *U.S. News & World Report* ranked St. John's graduate program in education as one of the top 50 graduate online programs in the nation.

Internships/placement

St. John's has established partnerships with many Catholic, public, and private schools, creating invaluable job and internship opportunities throughout the New York area. University Career Services provides assistance to candidates as they seek to identify opportunities for advancement.
