RETENTION RATES

- 82% of Fall 2018 Full-time, First-time Baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking freshmen students returned in Fall 2019. 82% of Fall 2018 All full-time, first-time Associate and baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking students returned in Fall 2019.
