**\*IMPORTANT**

- Tuition and Fees are due in full by the due date of each semester.
- Only students who have no previous balance from prior terms are permitted to enroll in a payment plan.
- Students who default on any payment plan payments will be charged 1% interest per month on the outstanding balance and the University reserves the right to cancel their enrollment for the semester
- Upon enrollment in the payment plan, your enrollment in the University for the semester will automatically be confirmed.
- Plan fees are non-refundable, even if plan is canceled or paid off early.
