

Fall EMT Basic Course 2021-3

Thank you for registering online for the St. John's University Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) program. To complete your registration and be guaranteed a seat in the program you must bring in two (2) separate money orders, one for tuition deposit and one for textbook/equipment fees. Only money orders are acceptable, no cash, credit cards or personal checks will be accepted. This tuition deposit and textbook/equipment fee are both non-refundable to guarantee you a seat in the program.

Due to restricted class size, registration for the EMT program is on a first come, first serve basis. Our class size is limited to 43 students. Registration is complete when St. John's University receives both your non-refundable tuition deposit of \$150, which will be credited towards the program tuition of \$1150, and the non-refundable textbook/equipment fee of \$225.

The St. John's University EMT program is a non-matriculated, non-credit continuing education class and financial aid and payments plans are not available for this program.

Students will be placed in the program in the order in which their tuition deposit and textbook/equipment fee is received. After the cap of 43 students is received no further registrations will be accepted and the registration deadline may be closed prior to the posted date.

The \$150.00 tuition deposit money order is made out to the order of **St. John's University**.

The \$225 textbook/equipment fee money order is made out to the order of **Frank Riboni**.

**The \$1000 balance of the tuition is due BEFORE the orientation class date on:
Monday, August 23, 2021**

Both money orders are due within seven (7) business days of this email being sent to the email address you provided. If we don't receive the tuition deposit and textbook/equipment fees by this date, we will remove you from our online registration list.

Because of the Covid Virus, all money orders must be mailed in.
