### STUDENT BODY DIVERSITY (*Full-time Undergraduates*)

- Gender Distribution of Full-time Undergraduates
  - 44% Male and 56% Female
- Ethnicity of Full-time Undergraduates:
  - 14% Black
  - 16% Asian
  - 17% Hispanic
  - 42% White
  - .1% Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander
  - 4% Non-Resident (International)
  - 5% Two or More Races
  - .3% American Indian
  - 2% Unknown
- 34% of the population were Federal Pell Grant Recipients

### RETENTION RATES

- 83% of Fall 2019 Full-time, First-time Baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking freshmen students returned in Fall 2020. 83% of Fall 2019 All full-time, first-time Associate and baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking students returned in Fall 2020.
