International Students Requesting Invitation to Commencement

Do you have family or guests coming from outside of the United States that need travel documentation? If yes, please follow the procedure below.

- 1. Student completes a letter request form from the Registrar's Office
- 2. Registrar confirms with deans' office to make sure they are on the graduation list
- 3. Once confirmed, Registrar creates a letter stating the student is expected to graduate and the ceremony is held on the Queens Campus

Notes:

- Students can have the letter picked up or mailed to them.
- Registrar does not send individual invitations to family members and produces as many letters as they request.

Diploma Ordering

Diplomas

- Graduates must submit an online diploma application in order to receive their diploma.
- The last day to order your diploma is Tuesday, May 16.

Instructions for the Online Application for Diploma:

- 1. Log onto University Information System (UIS) via signon.stjohns.edu
- 2. Go to the *Student* tab.
- 3. Select Graduation > Application for Diploma

Pick-Up Dates

Diplomas will be available after Friday, July 14, dependent upon the date the diploma was ordered. Contact your dean's
office for more information.

Diplomas are ordered throughout the spring term, if a student applied late for their diploma, it will not be available at the beginning of diploma distribution. Be sure to call your dean's office beforehand to confirm your diploma is available. (See pages 20 – 21 for your dean's contact information)

Student Academic Attire Purchase – Herff Jones & Bookstore

All graduates must purchase academic attire in order to participate in the Commencement Exercises. Wearing academic attire (cap, gown and hood) is both a tradition and a requirement to participate in the Commencement Exercises. Herff Jones will host the ordering website with a home ship or an on campus pick-up option. The Herff Jones website can be accessed here.

Home Ship Academic Attire

Graduates can home ship academic attire now through Friday, April 21, 2023.

- A standard shipping cost will be incurred to ship attire to a student's home address.
- Standard processing / shipping takes up to 3 weeks within the continental US. International orders can take up to 4 weeks to process.

Pre-Purchase Academic Attire

Graduates can pre-purchase academic attire now through Friday, March 17, 2023.

- -Queens/Manhattan Campus Students who pre-purchase attire will be given the opportunity to pick-up their attire at the Campus Bookstore on the Queens campus between Monday, April 24 through Commencement Day during regular business hours.
- Staten Island Campus Students who pre-purchase attire will have the opportunity to pick-up attire on the Staten Island campus on Thursday, April 27 between 1 6 p.m. and on Tuesday, May 9 between 12 4 p.m.

Student Registration - MarchingOrder

Graduates must register to attend and participate in the Undergraduate-Level Commencement Exercises. Students who have been deemed eligible to participate by their respective dean's office may register to attend the Commencement Exercises. To confirm your eligibility status, contact your dean's office immediately.

Graduates will receive communications via their St. John's email with instructions on how to register.

- Registration begins on Tuesday, March 28 and ends on Monday, April 24.
- Graduates will submit a pronunciation recording and provide the phonetics of their name which will assist in preparing the recording of their name for use as they cross the stage on commencement day.
- Following registration, graduates will be able to claim their five (5) guest tickets online.
- Registration must be completed for graduates' personalized GradPass to be created.

If you require special accommodations of any kind on graduation day, please notify your dean's office immediately.

Student GradPass

Each student needs to complete the registration process on the MarchingOrder site to receive their personalized GradPass on Commencement Day. Instructions to register on MarchingOrder will be sent to each student via their St. John's email account in March.

- On Commencement Day, students will check-in at their line-up areas, receive and have their GradPass scanned.
- As the graduate approaches the stage during the calling of names, their GradPass will be scanned a second time.
- The GradPass will allow for the pre-recorded name of each graduate to be announced as the graduate walks across the stage.
- The GradPass will also allow for the graduates' name to be displayed on the large viewing screens, as the graduate walks across the stage.
- After the graduate crosses the stage, they are expected to return to their seats for the remainder of the ceremony and to recess out together with their fellow classmates.

Student Guest Tickets

All guests are required to present a ticket for entry to the Undergraduate-Level Commencement Exercises on the Great Lawn or simulcast location. Children under the age of two do not require a ticket; however, they must be seated on an adult's lap. Seating for guests is based on the order of arrival, and seats cannot be saved. All ticket holders must be present at the time of entry to be seated together. As the ceremony is heavily attended, we recommend that family and guests arrive early and are seated on the lawn by 8:15 a.m. (1 hour prior to the start of the procession) or by 8:45 a.m. the latest.

Students will be able to reserve, print and/or email their allotted guest tickets on the MarchingOrder Site. Students are required to complete their registration, provide phonetics for the pronunciation of their pre-recorded name before they can reserve their guest tickets. On the day of the ceremony, guest can bring tickets in paper or electronic form.

- Each graduate participating in the Undergraduate-Level Commencement Exercises will receive five (5) guest tickets.
- Guest tickets will be scanned on the day of the ceremony.
 - o Tickets cannot be assigned to more than one individual or be duplicated
 - o Tickets can only be scanned once, for admittance into the ceremony.
- Additional tickets are not available. It is recommended that Graduates in need of additional tickets, reach out to fellow Johnnies who may not be utilizing all their tickets.
- The Commencement Exercises will also be streamed live for those guests unable to attend the ceremony on our Commencement website at www.stjohns.edu/commencement.

Commencement Day

Graduate Responsibilities

- Arrive at your assembly location no later than 8 a.m.
- Wear your academic attire (gown, hood, and cap) to the Commencement Exercises. Your tassel should be on the right side of your cap.
- Wear comfortable footwear and clothing, bring sunscreen and sunglasses.
- If rain is in the forecast, bring a small umbrella. NOTE: Umbrellas will not be permitted on stage during the calling of names.
- It is strongly recommended not to bring personal belongings.
- Graduates will be provided water and, if needed, a rain poncho.
- Be sure to pick-up your personalized GradPass during check-in.
- Follow the line-up, processional and recessional instructions of your academic deans, marshals and event staff.
- Once directed to your row in the graduate seating area, remain standing until the end of the Invocation.
- Follow the instructions for the calling of your name as you are asked to walk across the stage.

If you need assistance during Commencement, please locate your dean, event staff, or a Public Safety Officer.

Assembly and Line-Up Locations

- There is no rehearsal for the Commencement Exercises.
- Each school/college has a designated assembly and line-up location (see below).
- The academic deans will be in the assembly area to check-in graduates, and to distribute their personalized GradPass.



Duration of Ceremony

• Great care has been taken to ensure the ceremony is completed as quickly and smoothly as possible. The ceremony is expected to last approximately 2 ½ hours. Graduates and guests are asked to please show respect to all graduates and remain until the end of the ceremony and the student recession has ended.

Lost and Found

Inclement Weather Plan

- The Commencement Exercises is held on the Great Lawn, rain or shine.
- If it is raining or rain is in the forecast on Commencement day, graduates and guests should come prepared with the appropriate rain gear. Graduates and guests will receive a poncho if it is raining; guests are advised to also bring raincoats and something to cover the seat of the lawn chair. Graduates should note that umbrellas will not be permitted on stage.
- If the ceremony is underway and severe weather conditions exist, the ceremony may be abbreviated and the calling of student names and the greeting of deans on stage may be omitted from the program. If the ceremony is abbreviated, graduates and guests should follow instructions as announced. It is advised that graduates prearrange a meeting place with family and guests in case the ceremony is abbreviated.
- If the ceremony cannot be held on the Great Lawn due to extreme or dangerous weather, the ceremony may be cancelled or postponed. No indoor facility on campus can accommodate the graduating class and thousands of guests. Every reasonable effort will be made to hold the ceremony as planned.

Directions By Car

From Manhattan:

Take the Queens Midtown Tunnel to the Long Island Expressway, exit at Utopia Parkway. Stay on the service road to Utopia Parkway and turn right. Follow Utopia Parkway to Union Turnpike; the campus is on the right.

From Brooklyn:

Option one: Take the Belt Parkway (East) to the Van Wyck Expressway (678 N.), exit at Main Street/Union Turnpike. Proceed to the third traffic light and make a right onto the Grand Central Parkway service road. Go left on Utopia Parkway (at fourth traffic light) and proceed to the campus.

Option two: Take the Jackie Robinson Parkway (East) to the Grand Central Parkway (East); exit at Utopia Parkway, and make a left onto the campus.

From the Bronx:

Option one: Take the Throgs Neck Bridge to the Clearview Expressway. Exit at Union Turnpike. Make a right and follow to Utopia Parkway; make a left and then a right onto the campus.

Option two: Take the Triboro Bridge to the Grand Central Parkway. Exit at Utopia Parkway. Turn left at the light and left onto the campus.

From Long Island (North):

Option one: Take the Northern State Parkway to the Grand Central Parkway, exit at 188th Street. Turn left at the light, and make an immediate right onto the service road. Follow the service road to Utopia Parkway; bear right to campus.

Option two: Take the Long Island Expressway and exit at Utopia Parkway. Make a left on Utopia Parkway and proceed to Union Turnpike. The campus is on the right.

From Long Island (South):

Take the Southern State Parkway to the Cross Island Parkway. Proceed to the Grand Central Parkway (West), and exit at 188th Street. Turn left at the light, and make an immediate right onto the service road. Follow the service road to Utopia Parkway and bear right to campus.

From I-95 (North or South) and I-80 (East):

Take I-95 or I-80 to the George Washington Bridge. Cross the bridge and take the Cross Bronx Expressway to I-295 to the Throgs Neck Bridge. Follow directions above from the Bronx (option one).

Directions By Public Transportation

I.N.D. Subway:

Take the "E" or "F" train to Kew Gardens/Union Turnpike. Take the Q-46 bus to Utopia Parkway and Union Turnpike.

I.R.T. Subway:

Take the "7" train to Main Street, Flushing. From there, take the Q-17 bus to Utopia Parkway and the Long Island Expressway. Transfer to the Q-30 or Q-31 bus, which you will take to 82nd Avenue and Utopia Parkway.

From Long Island:

Take the L.I.R.R. to Jamaica Station, and catch the Q-30 to 82nd Avenue and Utopia Parkway.

- Graduates and guests are advised to carpool.




