BACKGROUND

- Founded by the Vincentian Community in 1870
- Mission: A Catholic, Vincentian, Metropolitan and Global University
- Core Values: truth, love, respect, opportunity, excellence, and service

ADMINISTRATION, FACULTY, AND STAFF

- President: Rev. Brian J. Shanley, O.P. - *18th President*
- A budget of \$457 million; and an endowment of \$868.9 million as of May 31, 2022
- \$10,984,134 in awarded grants funds; 113 proposals submitted
- Over 2,500 employees including:
 - Faculty: Full-time – 618; Part-time – 775; Full-time Equivalent (FTE): 928
 - Administrators: Full-time – 650; Part-time – 63
 - Staff: Full-time – 281; Part-time – 130

COMPOSITION

- Full degree programs offered on four campuses – Queens, Staten Island, Manhattan, and Rome, Italy; selected degree programs are offered through Online Learning.
- Coursework, but not full degrees, are offered at Study Abroad sites in Paris, France and Limerick, Ireland.
- Six schools and colleges:
 - St. John's College of Liberal Arts and Sciences*
 - The School of Education*
 - The Peter J. Tobin College of Business*
 - College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences*
 - The Lesley H. and William L. Collins College of Professional Studies*
 - School of Law*
- Over one hundred undergraduate and graduate majors
- Approximate acreage: Queens - 102 acres; Staten Island - 16.5

STUDENTS

- Total Enrollment: – 19,663
 - Undergraduate – 15,652 Graduate – 4,011
 - First-time, First-year students – 2,905
- Resident students living on or around the Queens campus – 2,522
- Students come from 45 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, US Virgin Islands & 118 countries
- 631 Non-Resident (International) from 96 countries
- Average ages: Undergraduate – 19; Graduate – 28; New First-time, First-year students – 18
- 57% Female, 43% Male
- 42% Roman Catholic
- 48% are Black, Hispanic, Asian, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, American Indian, Alaska Native, or Two or More Races
- Full-time baccalaureate 1st year retention rate: 2021 entering class - 82%
- Full-time baccalaureate 6-year graduation rate: 2016 entering class - 69%
- 4,061 degrees conferred in the 2021-2022 academic year

ANNUAL EXPENSES (2022-2023)

- Undergraduate Tuition – \$46,230 (may vary by program, class year, and campus/location)
Fees: \$1,350 (may vary) Room (double)/board: \$18,790 (may vary)
- Graduate Tuition - \$1,400 per credit (varies by program)

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION (2021-2022)

- 99% of undergraduates received financial aid
- \$494 million distributed in financial aid
- \$296.6 million of university monies distributed to students
- 41% of the 2022 First-time, First-Year students are considered Pell-eligible/Very High Need
