- 1. Insurance Card: For you Member ID
- 2. **<u>RxBin # or Bin #:</u>** This can be found on your Insurance Card. If it is not on your insurance card check your pharmacy card. For Aetna (which is the SJU Health insurance plan) the RxBin # is **004336**. If you have insurance other than Aetna and are still unsure, please contact your insurance carrier.
- 3. <u>Date of Last Dose of COVID-19 Vaccine</u>: You can find this on your COVID-19 vaccination card or from the NY Immunization Registries. You will need your COVID-19 Immunization Card the day of the event if you are receiving a second, third or booster dose.

### Day of the Event Instructions:

Please show up 15 minutes prior to your appointment time for check in.

- Items to Bring with you:
  - Insurance Card: All students who wish to use their insurance will need to bring their insurance card with them for billing. If you have Medicare you will need to bring your red, white and blue Medicare card. If your insurance card does not show the RxBin # or Bin # on it, you will need to bring your Pharmacy Card.
  - o Photo ID
  - Form of Payment: Only for students who do not have insurance and wish to pay out of pocket.
  - You will need your CDC vaccination card if you're coming in for a COVID-19 second dose, booster or extra dose appointment.
  - If you're getting a COVID-19 Vaccine, be prepared to stay for 15 to 30 minutes after you receive your dose so that you can be observed for side effects.
  - At the time that you scheduled your appointment, you should have received an email or text confirmation. You can cancel your appointment directly from the link provided in the text or email.
