EUROPE - SPRING 2024

RMI 3350 (Re) Insurance Leadership in Markets and Society Requires an online application and interview

Students accepted into this program will travel to: Zurich, Munich, and London, and will visit the headquarters of leading insurance companies overseas. This course prepares students for professional careers in risk management and insurance via discussions about US and foreign insurance and reinsurance operations in target countries. Classes will be delivered in a hybrid learning format with selected face-to-face meetings in Manhattan. The course anticipates a separate weekend trip to Bermuda in March 2024.

Approximate Travel Dates: February 23 - March 3, 2024

Program Fee: \$500 (including airfare)

Eligibility Criteria: GSRM majors with a 3.5GPA (unless exempted) and have completed at least RMI 1301 by Fall 2023. Preference is given to students who have completed more RMI courses. Students will be selected by the professor and will be given an application and interview.
