How do I enroll in the Payment Plan?	These payment plans are online self-enrollment only by a student or authorized user on the student's account. Log into your personal UIS account, select Student, Registration, View term Bill for the term and proceed to the Student Account Suite, then select the Payment Plans tab. Only online payment using a credit card or checking/savings account are accepted for online payment plan enrollment. Wire Transfers, certified bank checks and cash payment plans, MUST be enrolled by a Student Financial Services representative as an In-House Plan and are 33% Down Payment and \$150 Fee with due dates similar to the Online Bronze Plan as future Installment payments are not automatic. Credit cards are no longer accepted in-person or by phone by Student Financial Services.			
May I authorize my parent or an authorized user to view and pay the bill?	Yes. Visit the Student Account Center through your UIS account and click "Authorized Users" under the My Account tab to add/change an Authorized User. Authorized Users receive eBill email notifications can make full payments and payment plans on the student's behalf.			

- Tuition and Fees are due in full or enrollment in the payment plan by the due date of each semester.
- Credit cards are not accepted in person or over the phone at Student Financial Services for tuition account payments.
- When an online credit card payment or payment plan installment is processed, TouchNet PayPath will assess a non-refundable service fee of 2.85% of your payment transaction amount at each transaction (\$3 minimum fee). The University does not control or process this fee.
- Only students who have no previous balance from prior terms are permitted to enroll in a payment plan. Prior balances cannot be carried forward.
- Students who default on any payment plan payments will be charged 1% interest per month on the outstanding balance and the University reserves the right to cancel their enrollment for the semester.
- Upon enrollment in the payment plan, your enrollment in the University for the semester will automatically be confirmed.
- Payment Plan fees are non-refundable, even if plan is canceled or paid off early.
