Criminal Law Essay #1

The issue presented in this fact pattern is whether the Owner is guilty of larceny by false pretense.

Larceny is defined as a taking and carrying away of tangible personal property, of another by trespass, with intent to permanently deprive the person of the property. In this fact pattern the Owner did commit larceny when he sold the refurbished computer to the customer. The Owner went beyond puffery to induce the customer to purchase. He told him that they were the best refurbished computers in town when he knew two other companies were better at refurbishing computers. He told the customer the technician installed new hard drives when he knew it was likely that new hard drives were not installed. He took possession of the \$250 for the purchase of the computer knowing that he gave false information to make the sale.

False Pretense is obtaining title to personal property of another by an intentional false statement with intent to defraud the other. The offense of false pretenses generally consists of (i) obtaining title: (ii) to the property of another: (iii) by a knowing (or in some states, intentional) false statement of past or existing fact; (iv) with the intent to defraud another. For the crime of false pretenses, title must pass (if title does not pass, the crime will be larceny by trick). In most states, the "knowing" element can be proved by showing that the defendant had notice of a high probability of the statement's falsity and a deliberate decision to avoid learning the truth. If the defendant believes the statement to be true, he has not committed false pretenses (even if his belief is unreasonable).

Intent to defraud can be proved by showing that the defendant intended for the victim to rely

on the misrepresentation.

The owner committed false pretense by telling the customer, "We have the best refurbished

computers in town." The owner knew they did not have the best refurbished computers in town as he

Commented [ds1]: So how is a purchase a "taking or carrying away"? this is not a straight larceny situation as you state below by knowing false pretenses. So this "analysis" of basic larceny was not time well spent. Focus on the false pretense issue and he didn't just steal (larceny) the customer's money.

Commented [ds2]: Good start to your rule. But remember, rule statements are more than a mere technicality to be placed the "Rule" place marker section in your IRAC or CRAC paradigm. Rather, rules are the foundation on which you will build your analysis. To score maximum points on an essay, you will need to provide more than just a mere recitation of the rule. You need to make sure that your rule is sufficient and you might also need to show the grader that you understand what the rule means and how it relates to the legal problem(s) by including an explicit rule explanation.

Commented [ds3]: And anytime the rule contains several distinct elements that must be met, number them.








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The Multistate Bar Exam: 50% of your score





200 multiple-choice questions, average scaled score is less than 70%






