### STUDENT BODY DIVERSITY (*Full-time Undergraduates*)

- Gender Distribution of Full-time Undergraduates
  - 46% Male and 54% Female
- Ethnicity of Full-time Undergraduates:
  - 15% Black
  - 16% Asian
  - 23% Hispanic
  - 37% White
  - .1% Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander
  - 3% Non-Resident (International)
  - 5% Two or More Races
  - .1% American Indian
  - 1% Unknown
- 39% of the population were Federal Pell Grant Recipients

### RETENTION RATES

- 80% of Fall 2022 Full-time, First-time Baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking freshmen students returned in Fall 2023.
- 80% of Fall 2022 All full-time, first-time Associate and baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking students returned in Fall 2023.
