- Founded by the Vincentian Community of Priests and Brothers in 1870
- Mission: A Catholic, Vincentian, Metropolitan and Global University
- Core Values: truth, love, respect, opportunity, excellence, and service

ADMINISTRATION, FACULTY, AND STAFF

- President: Rev. Brian J. Shanley, O.P. - *18th President*
- A budget of \$498 million; and an endowment of \$819.4 million as of May 31, 2024
- \$9,101,486 in awarded grants funds; 97 proposals submitted in FY24
- Over 2,700 employees including:
 - Faculty: Full-time – 615; Part-time – 742; Full-time Equivalent (FTE): 943
 - Administrators: Full-time – 757; Part-time – 68
 - Staff: Full-time – 303; Part-time – 272

COMPOSITION

- Full degree programs offered on the Queens and Manhattan campuses and selected degree programs are offered through Online Learning.
- Coursework, but not full degrees, are offered at Study Abroad sites in Rome, Italy; Paris, France; and Limerick, Ireland.

STUDENTS

- Total Enrollment: – 19,389
 - Undergraduate – 15,640 Graduate – 3,749
 - First-time, First-year students – 2,350
- Resident students living on or around the Queens campus – 2,479
- Students come from 45 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, US Virgin Islands & 122 countries
- 650 Non-Resident (International) from 106 countries
- Average ages: Undergraduate – 20; Graduate – 28; New First-time, First-year students – 18
- 57% Female, 43% Male
- 39% Roman Catholic
- 50% are Black, Hispanic, Asian, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, American Indian, Alaska Native, or Two or More Races
- Full-time baccalaureate 1st year retention rate: 2023 entering class - 79%
- Full-time baccalaureate 6-year graduation rate: 2018 entering class - 66%
- 3,482 degrees conferred in the 2023-2024 academic year

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION (2023-2024 Academic Year)

- 97% of undergraduates received financial aid
- \$542.4 million distributed in financial aid
- \$316.3 million of university monies distributed to students
- 44% of First-time, First-year students were Pell-eligible/Very High Need
