STUDENT BODY DIVERSITY (*Full-time Undergraduates*)

- Gender Distribution of Full-time Undergraduates
 - 46% Male and 54% Female
- Ethnicity of Full-time Undergraduates:
 - 16% Black
 - 16% Asian
 - 25% Hispanic
 - 34% White
 - .1% Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander
 - 4% Non-Resident (International)
 - 5% Two or More Races
 - .2% American Indian
 - 1% Unknown
- 43% of the population were Federal Pell Grant Recipients

RETENTION RATES

- 79% of Fall 2023 Full-time, First-time Baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking freshmen students returned in Fall 2024.
- 78% of Fall 2023 All full-time, first-time Associate and baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking students returned in Fall 2024.
