



CUNY¹ is the nation's largest public university with an FY 2024 operating budget of \$4.2 billion.

St. John's is a Catholic and Vincentian university with an operating budget of \$505 million.

CUNY receives more than half of its funding from New York State, with tuition revenue accounting for 32% and the remaining 14% from New York City.

St. John's is largely dependent on tuition and fees, comprising 75% of its operating income.

CUNY has experienced three consecutive years of enrollment growth.³

St. John's saw its first-year student enrollment drop 12% in Fall 2024. Projected first-year enrollment in Fall 2025 was 2,650, regaining ground lost in 2024 but still lower than Fall 2023 (2,674).
