BACKGROUND

- Founded by the Vincentian Community of Priests and Brothers in 1870
- Mission: A Catholic, Vincentian, Metropolitan and Global University
- Core Values: truth, love, respect, opportunity, excellence, and service

ADMINISTRATION, FACULTY, AND STAFF

- President: Rev. Brian J. Shanley, O.P. - *18th President*
- A budget of **\$505** million; and an endowment of **\$856.3** million as of May 31, 2025
- **\$8,044,707** in awarded grants funds; **91** proposals submitted in FY25
- **Over 2,400** employees including:
 - Faculty: Full-time – **608**; Part-time – **680**; Full-time Equivalent (FTE): **911**
 - Administrators: Full-time – **727**; Part-time – **49**
 - Staff: Full-time – **277**; Part-time – **158**

COMPOSITION

- Full degree programs offered on the Queens and Manhattan campuses and selected degree programs are offered through Online Learning.
- Coursework, but not full degrees, are offered at Study Abroad sites in Rome, Italy; Paris, France; and Limerick, Ireland.

STUDENTS

- Total Enrollment: – **20,435**
 - Undergraduate – **16,651** Graduate – **3,784**
 - First-time, First-year students – **2,602**
- Resident students living on or around the Queens campus – **2,524**
- Students come from **45** states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and **125** countries
- **597** Non-Resident (International) from **110** countries
- Average ages: Undergraduate – **20**; Graduate – **29**; New First-time, First-year students – **18**
- **58%** Female, **42%** Male
- **40%** Roman Catholic
- **51%** are Black, Hispanic, Asian, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, American Indian, Alaska Native, or Two or More Races
- Full-time baccalaureate 1st year retention rate: **2024** entering class - **79%**
- Full-time baccalaureate 6-year graduation rate: **2019** entering class - **69%**
- **3,543** degrees conferred in the **2024-2025** academic year

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION (2024-2025 Academic Year)

- **99%** of undergraduates received financial aid
- **\$549.4** million distributed in financial aid
- **\$328.8** million of university monies distributed to students
- **46%** of First-time, First-year students were Pell-eligible/Very High Need
