A RICH HISTORY

The Maurice R. Greenberg School of Risk Management, Insurance and Actuarial Science has a storied history spanning more than a century. Founded in 1901 as the Insurance Society of New York, it evolved into the School of Insurance in 1947, and later became The College of Insurance (TCI). In 1984, TCI opened its Manhattan home at 101 Murray Street. In 2001, St. John's University merged with TCI, and in 2014 the School moved to 101 Astor Place, continuing its tradition of excellence. In 2020, it was renamed in honor of Maurice R. "Hank" Greenberg, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of C.V. Starr & Co. Inc., reflecting the School's ongoing leadership in shaping the future of risk management, insurance, and actuarial science.
