 - 5% Non-Resident (International)
 - 5% Two or More Races
 - 1% American Indian
 - 6% Unknown

RETENTION RATES

- 84% of Fall 2017 Full-time, First-time Baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking freshmen students returned in Fall 2018. 84% of Fall 2017 All full-time, first-time Associate and baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking students returned in Fall 2018.
