



Academic Center for Equity and Inclusion (ACEI) Mini-Grant for Inclusive Teaching & Learning Application

The ACEI Faculty Mini-Grant is intended to provide support for ALL faculty members seeking to develop curricular/co-curricular activities, enhance teaching skills and improve teaching practices, and/or research initiatives/innovations that center issues of diversity, equity, and inclusion in teaching and learning. A limited number of grants are available each year.

Grant recipients must prepare a report describing how your ACEI Faculty Mini-Grant for Inclusive Teaching and Learning project will improve student learning and the learning environment and aligns with the University's equity and inclusion goals. The report is to be submitted within three (3) months of attending the funded program or developing your teaching materials, with copies sent to the ACEI Director, Dean, and Department/Division Chairperson. By accepting this grant, you also agree to present your experience in the form of an ACEI workshop and an article in the Office of Equity and Inclusion newsletter.

Application Process:

1. Title and description of the conference/workshop you would like to attend (including dates and location) and a brief explanation of why you have selected this program.

2. Explanation of how you intend to incorporate information and skills learned to foster collaboration, conversation, and community among faculty invested in these issues and to generate resources that contribute to equity work within our learning community.

3. Explanation of how you will share what you have learned with your St. John's colleagues.

4. Budget breakdown of program-related expenses. ACEI Faculty Mini-Grants are for reimbursement of expenses only and do not include stipends or funds for a faculty member's time.

5. Please attach a letter of recommendation from your Dean, Department/Division Chair, OR mentor.
