STUDENT BODY DIVERSITY (*Full-time Undergraduates*)

 - 43% Male and 57% Female
- Ethnicity of Full-time Undergraduates:

 - 5% Non-Resident (International)
 - 5% Two or More Races
 - 1% American Indian
 - 8% Unknown
- 40% of the population were Federal Pell Grant Recipients

RETENTION RATES

- 84% of Fall 2016 Full-time, First-time Baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking freshmen students returned in Fall 2017. 83% of Fall 2016 All full-time, first-time Associate and baccalaureate/PharmD degree seeking students returned in Fall 2017.
