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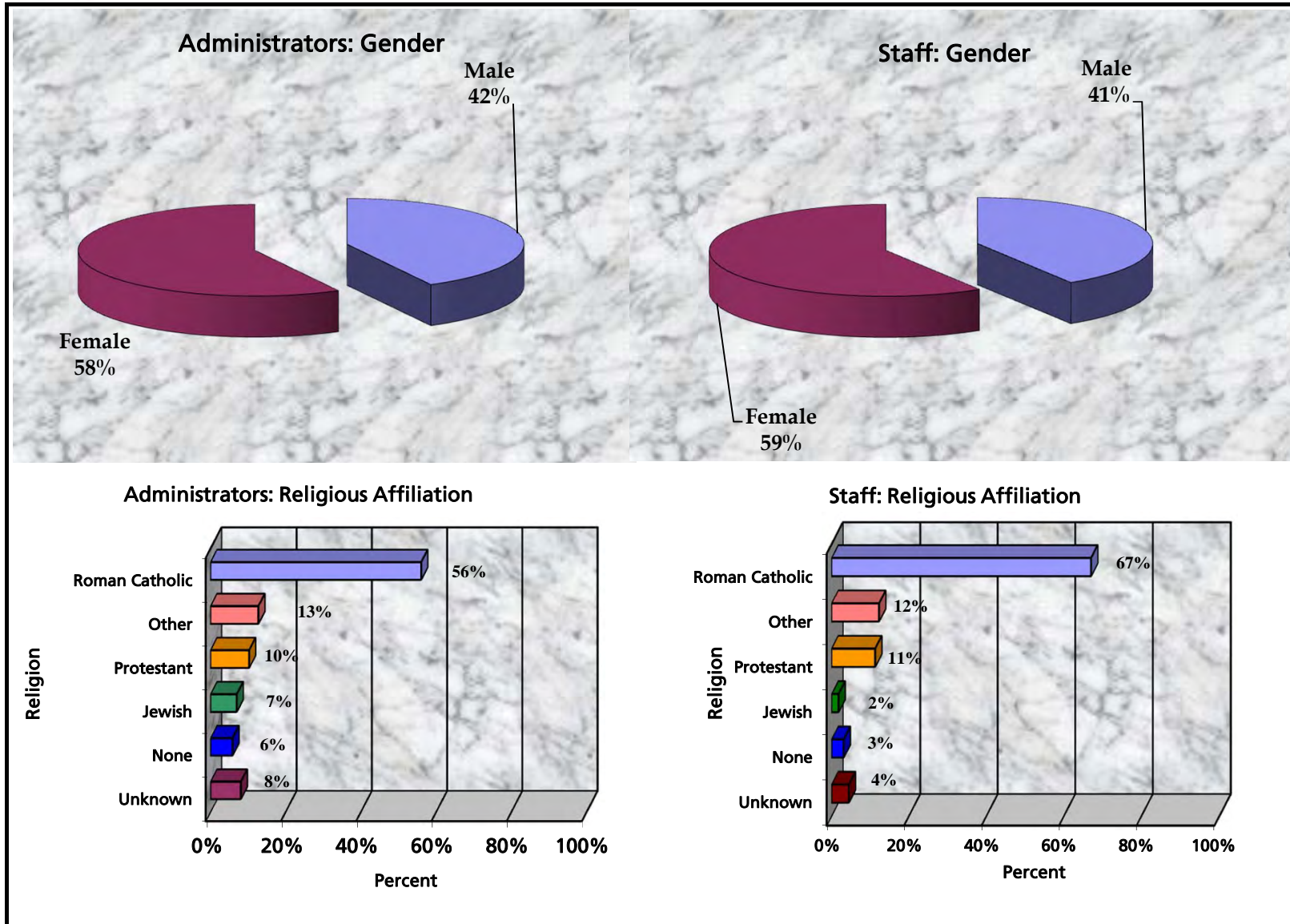

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Demographic Characteristics of Full-time and Part-time Administrators and Staff Fall 2016

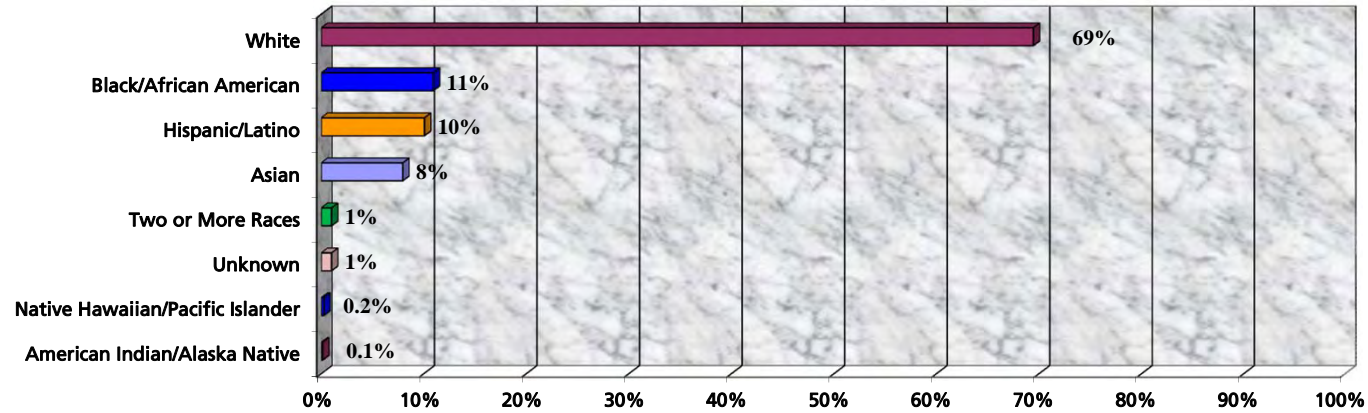

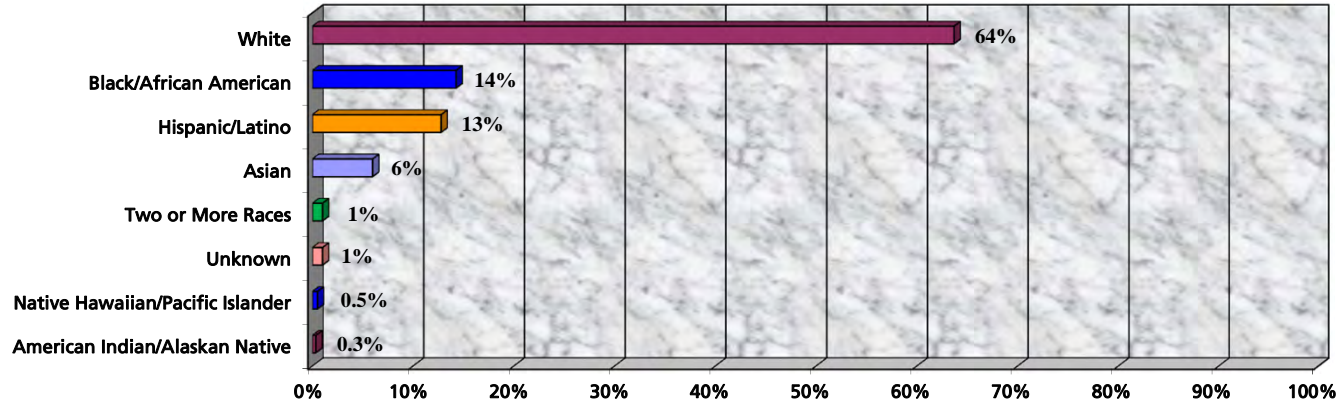

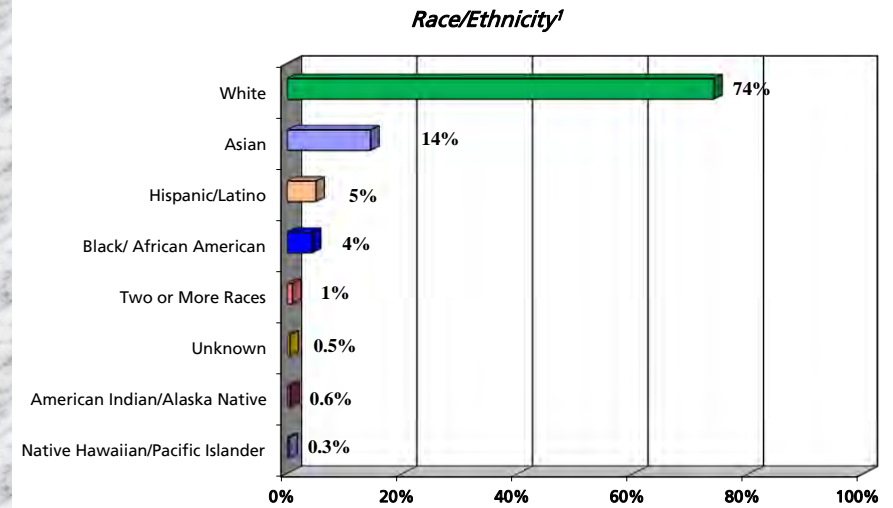

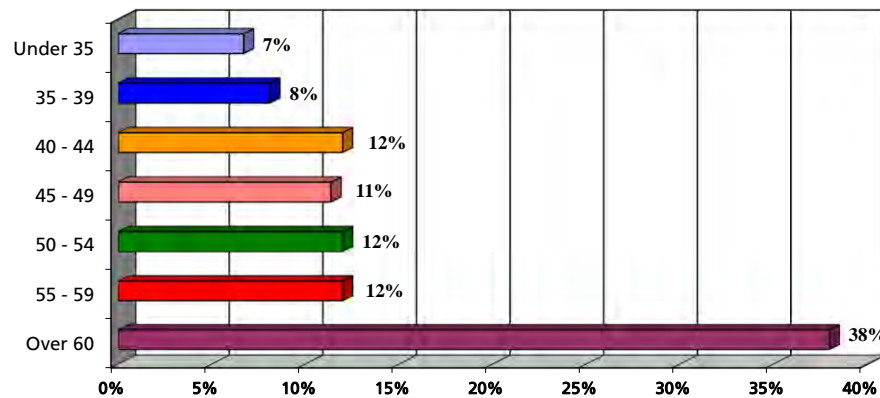

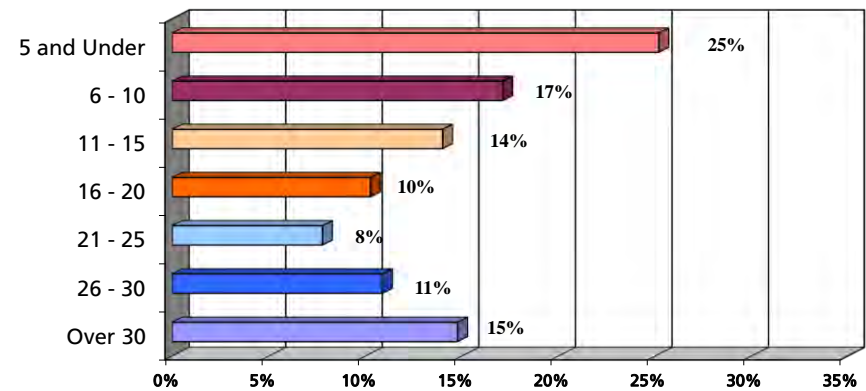
Demographic Characteristics of Full-Time Faculty Fall 2016



Age Distribution



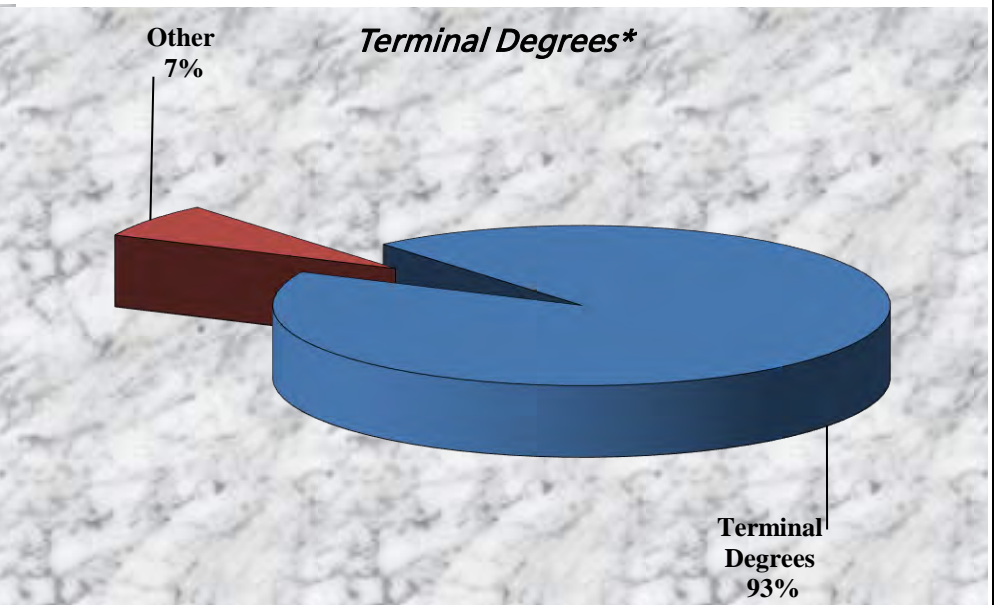
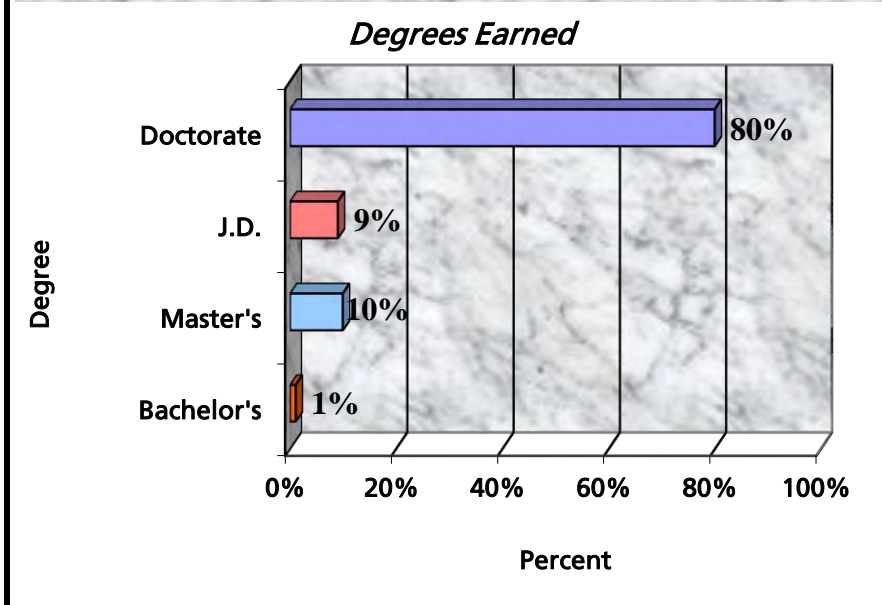
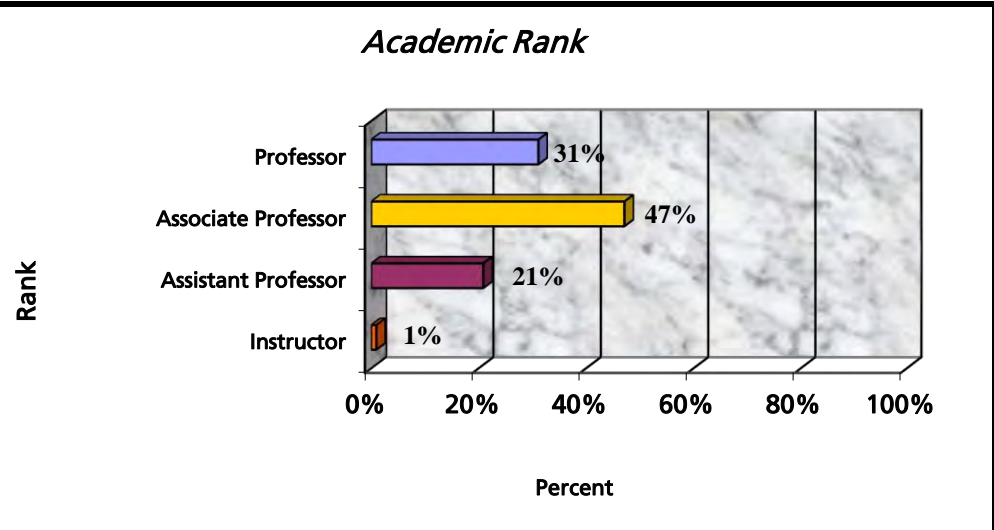
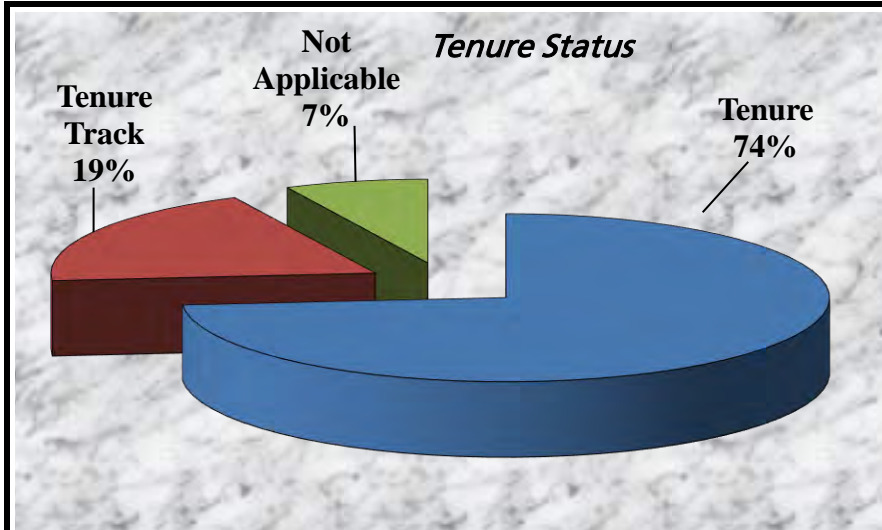

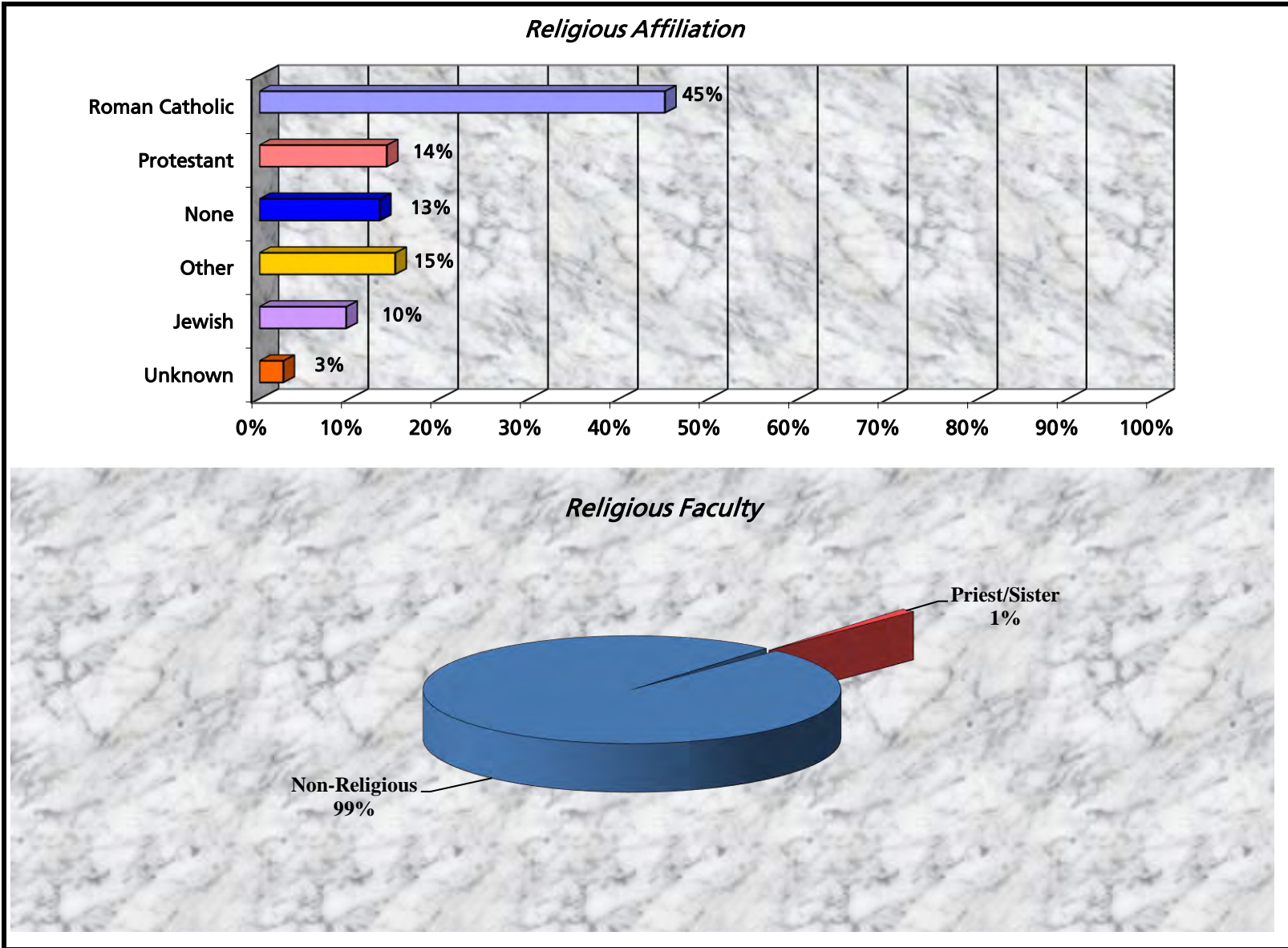
Demographic Characteristics of Full-time Faculty Fall 2016

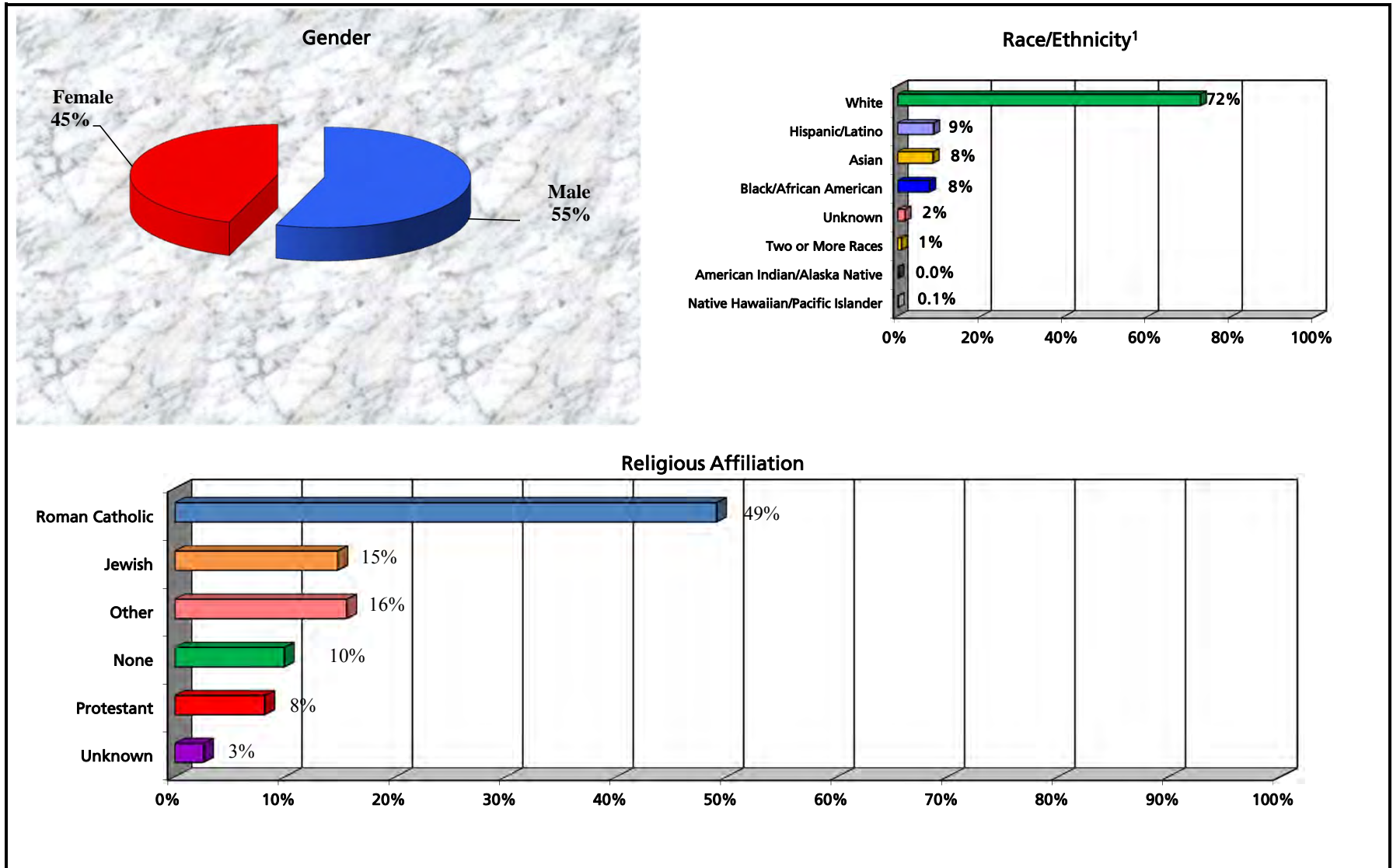
