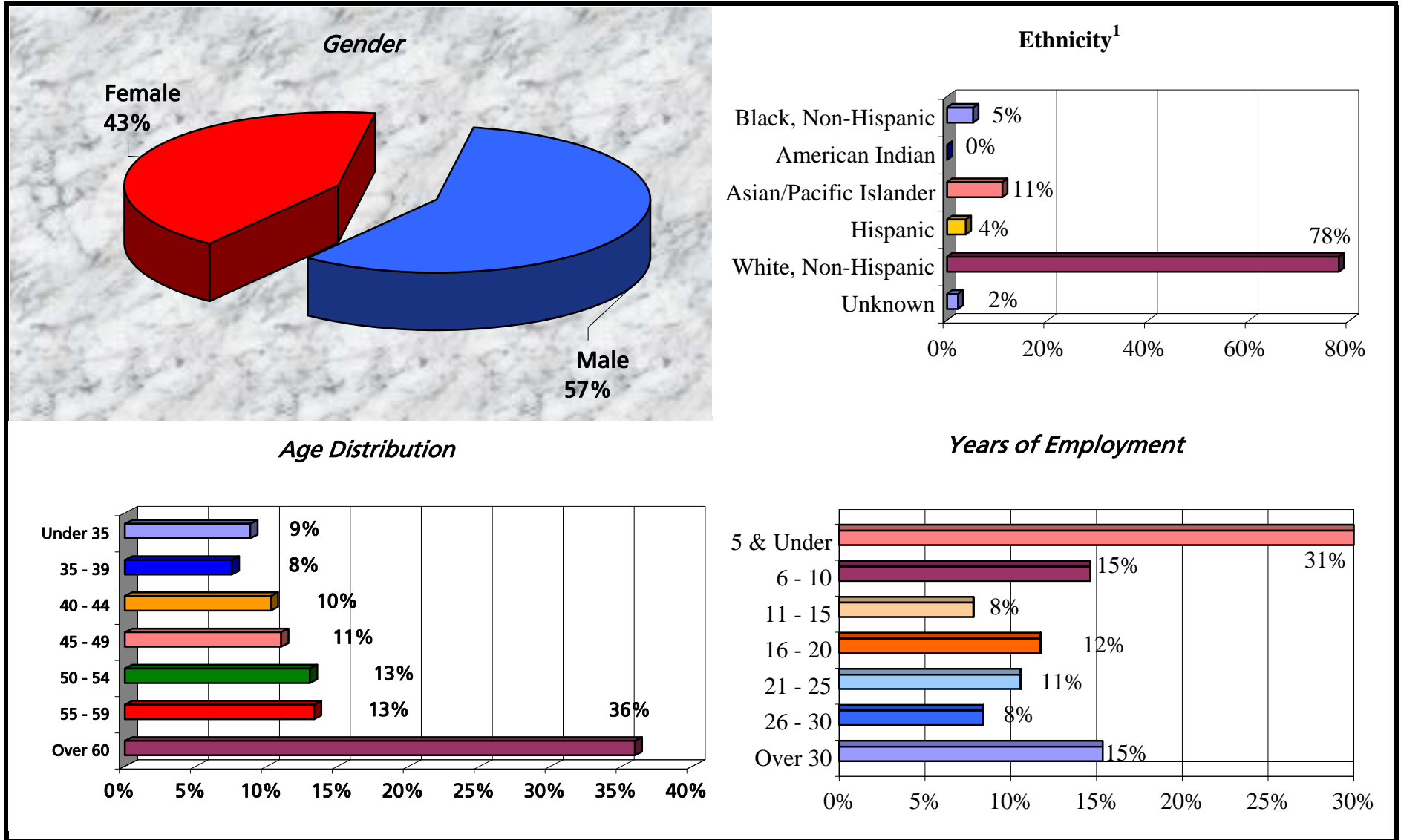

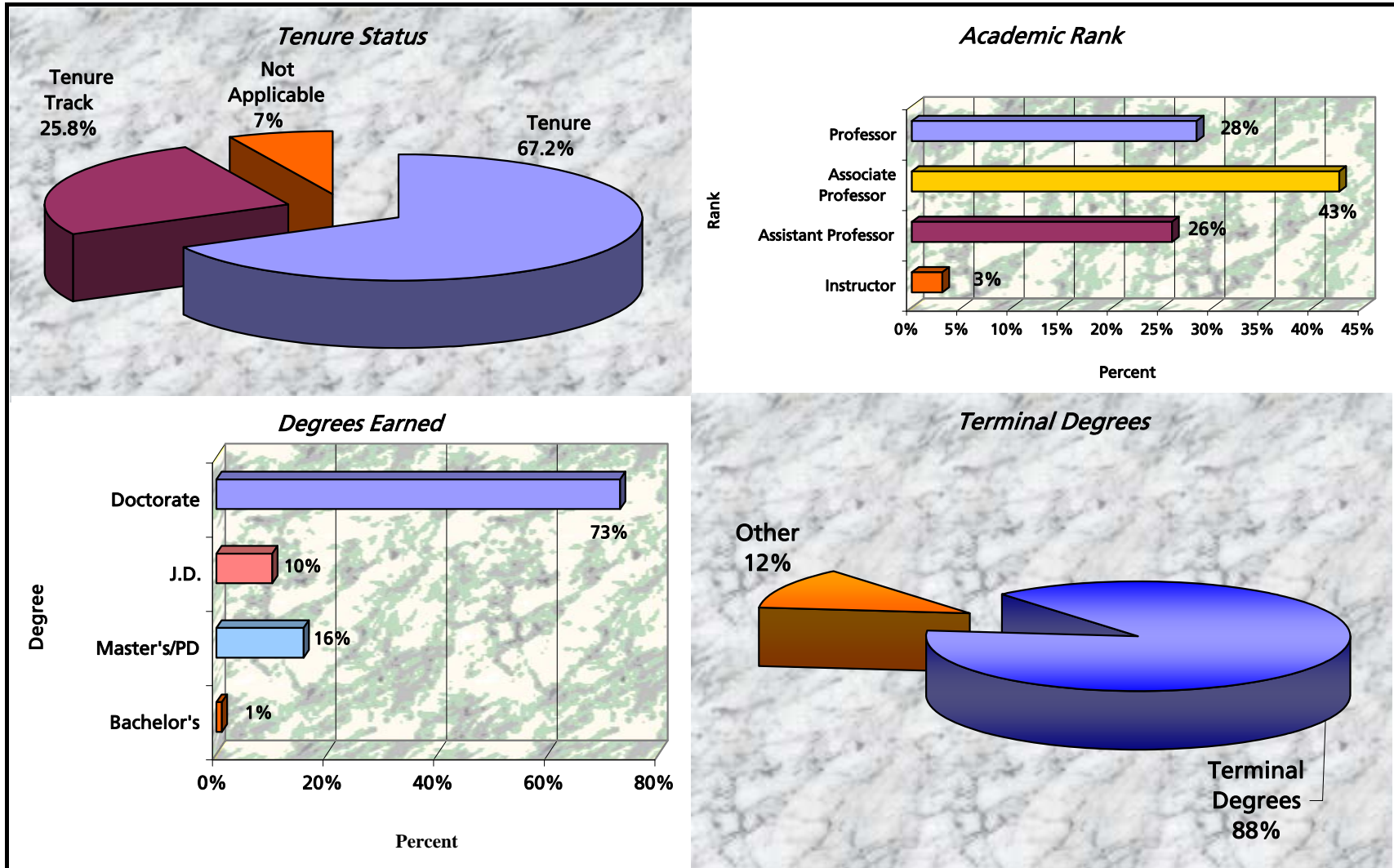

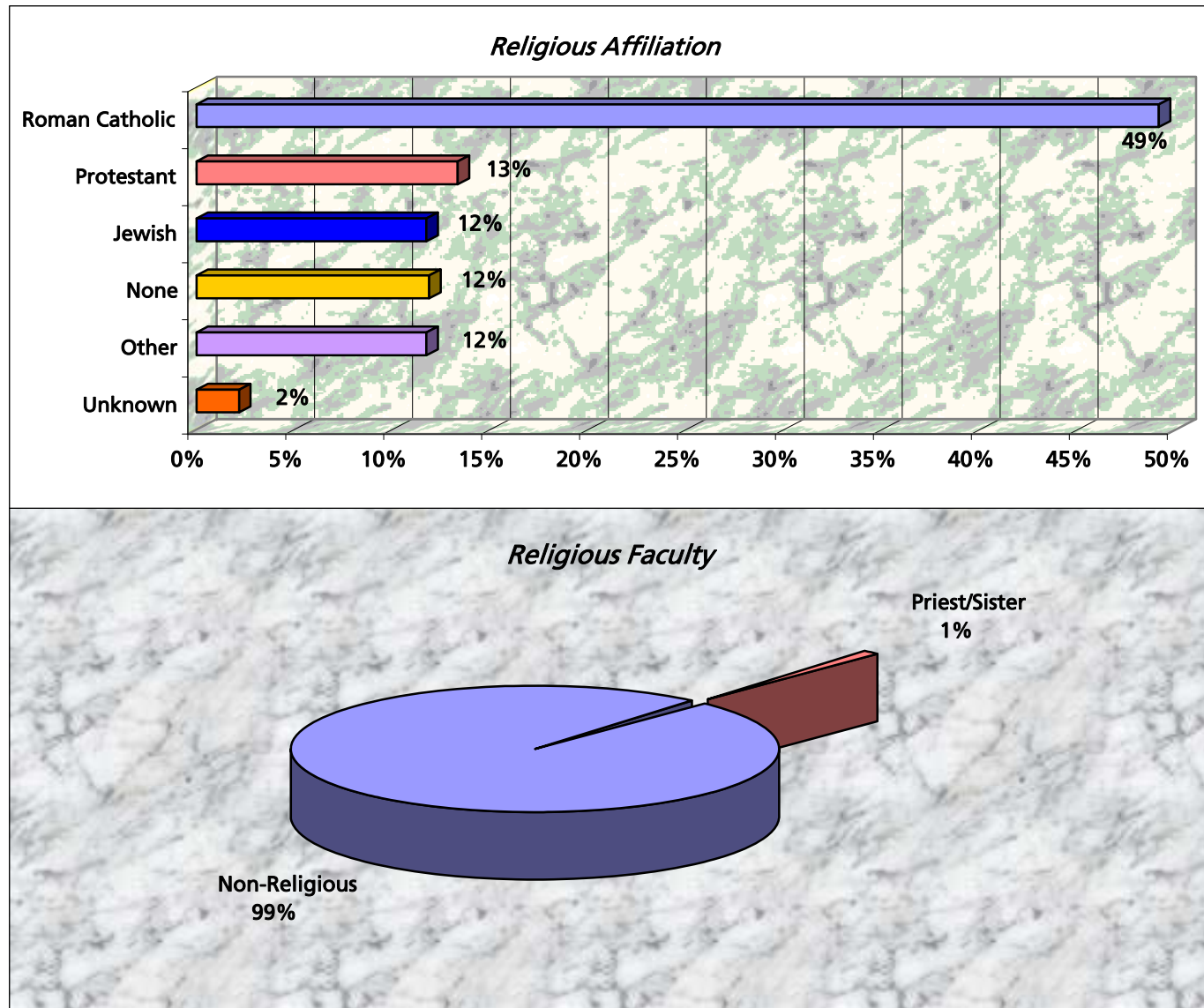
## Demographic Characteristics of Full-time Faculty Fall 2009

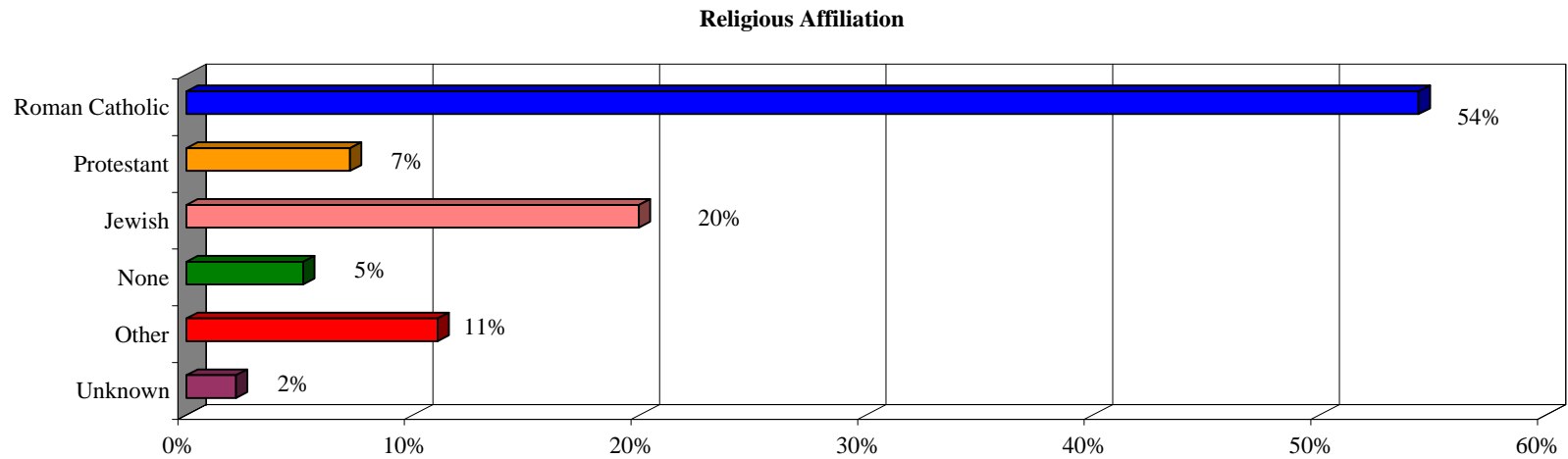
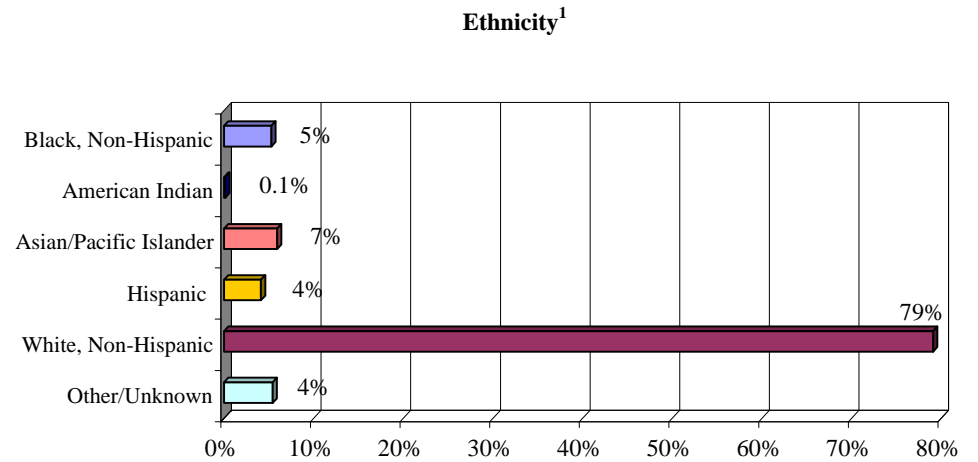
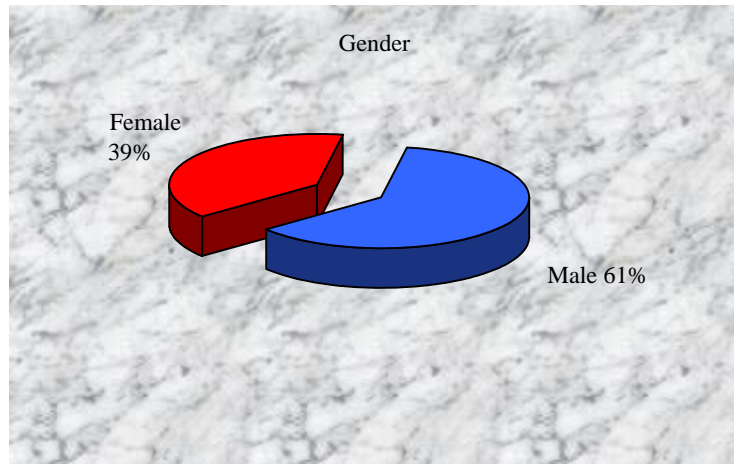
