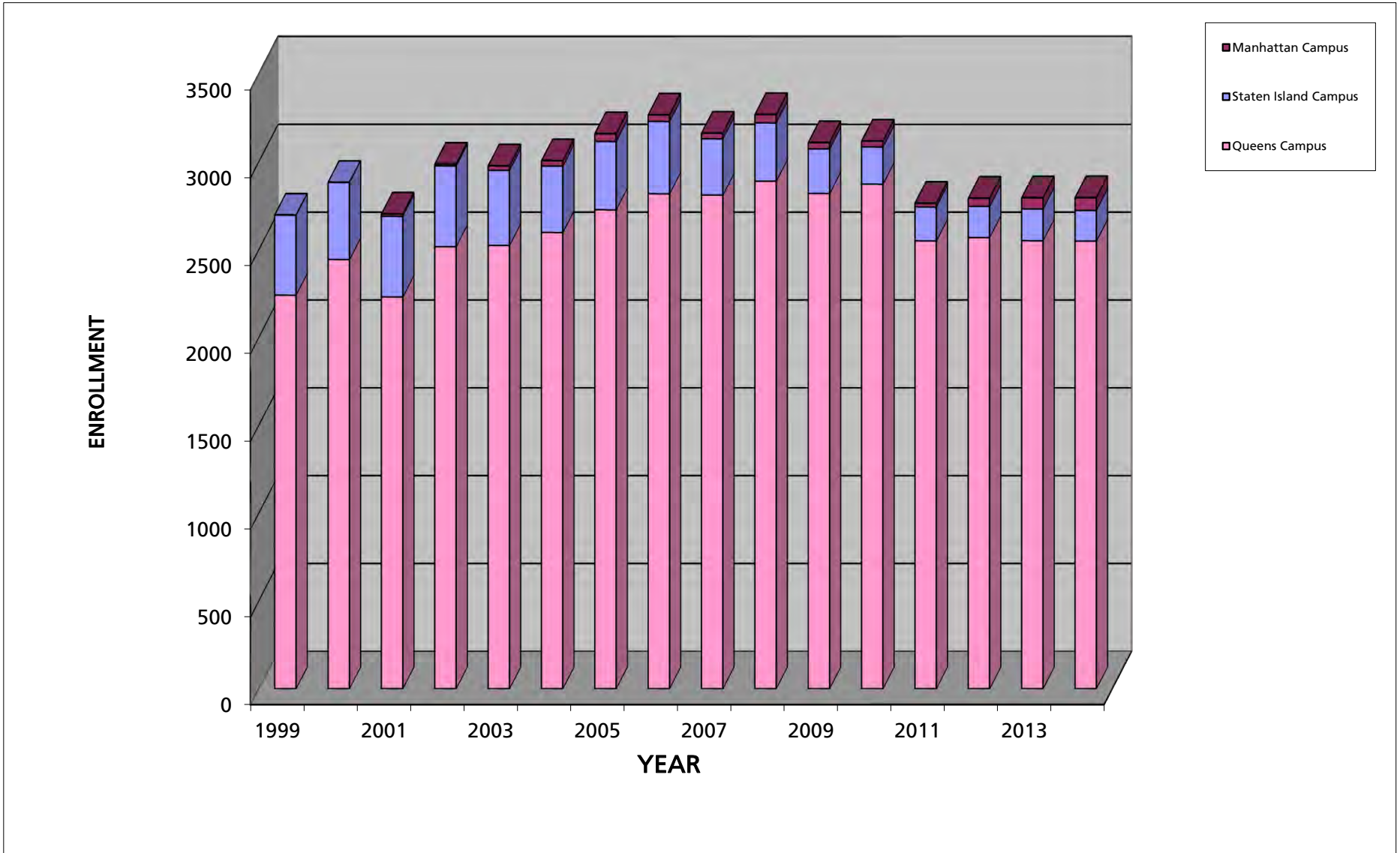

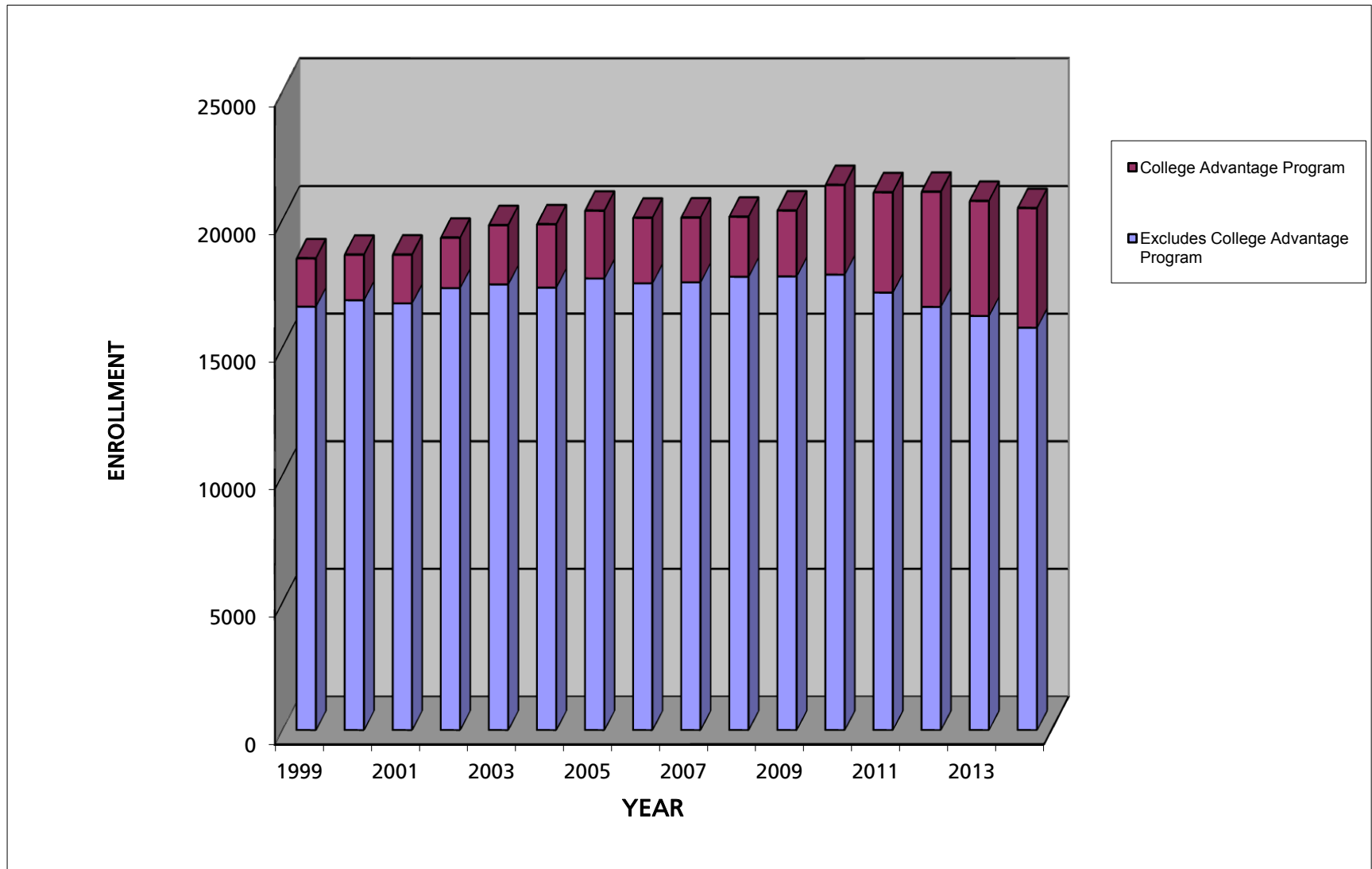


## Trends in New Freshmen Fall 1999 - Fall 2014
