ABOUT THE THREE-YEAR B.A. DEGREE PROGRAMS

St. John's University offers three-year bachelor of arts degree options on our Staten Island campus for English, government and politics, psychology, and speech-language pathology and audiology. These are intensive programs of study for motivated and academically high-achieving students who wish to complete their undergraduate work in a condensed course of study.

The three-year B.A. programs welcome students who exhibit strong leadership qualities and are articulate and focused about their interests in one of the applicable areas of study. As a student in one of these programs, you will be required to complete 18 credits during each of six fall/spring semesters and nine credits during each of two summers. (Students in the three-year B.A. Speech-Language Pathology program must complete 19 credits each fall/spring semester and three summers of courses.) You will also spend a summer abroad at either St. John's Rome, Italy, campus or our Paris, France, location to enhance your global understanding and round out your education while still completing your degree in just three years.

WHY SHOULD I EARN A B.A. IN THREE YEARS?

The three-year degree programs offer a focused course of study for highly motivated students who are especially eager to get on to graduate work or start their careers. By completing the bachelor's degree in three years, you'll demonstrate discipline and focus to potential employers and graduate schools. Since the admissions requirements for the three-year B.A. degrees are higher than our traditional four-year undergraduate degrees, being accepted into one of these intensive, condensed programs is a testament to your dedication, work ethic, and commitment to success.
