

Submission of Master's Portfolio or E-Portfolio

Procedures: Students who wish to submit a portfolio will meet for initial advisement with their department chair/advisor. The student must present his/her advisor with an unofficial graduate transcript (available through UIS) as proof that he/she is prepared to submit the portfolio. The advisor must sign the application to show approval.

The student must then bring the portfolio, the unofficial transcript, and this application form to the Dean's office for submission by the date specified in the graduate bulletin.
